Dear Parent/Guardian,

We have been notified that a person has tested positive for Covid-19 (coronavirus) in your child's school. The Department of Public Health - Midlands has carried out a full public health risk assessment.

The affected person did not attend the school during the infectious period and is not an infection risk to others. Therefore no other child or staff member has been identified as a close contact.

This means that they do not need to be tested for Covid-19. Your child can continue to go to school and to all their usual activities as normal.

We are asking you to:

- Monitor your child for any symptoms of Covid-19.
Symptoms of Covid-19 include a fever (temperature of 38°C or higher), cough, shortness of breath or any loss or change to their sense of smell or taste.

What if your child develops symptoms of coronavirus?

If your child develops symptoms of coronavirus, you need to:

- Isolate your child – this means keep them at home and completely avoid contact with other people. This includes other people in your household.
- Phone your GP or out-of-hours GP service for advice. Contact them immediately if your child's symptoms of coronavirus (Covid-19) get worse.
- Restrict the movements of everyone in the house. This means other people in the house should try to avoid coming into contact with others, and should not go to work or to school or childcare.
